

## Licensing and Trainings in the Diocese of El Camino Real

Lay Licenses offered according to The Episcopal Church Canon III.4.1: Pastoral Leader, Worship Leader, Preacher, Eucharistic Minister, Eucharistic Visitor, Evangelist, Catechist. All are LAY licenses.

Role of the COM, according to this Canon: "Requirements and guidelines for the selection, training, continuing education, and deployment of such persons, and the duration of licenses shall be established by the Bishop in consultation with the Commission on Ministry."
